

Master Fee Schedule
Effective November 1, 2014

INTRODUCTION:

Actual costs are subject to a minimum of 1/2 hour of the Fully Burdened Overhead Rate for positions performing service. Production costs and discrete costs incurred by City will also be passed through. Advance deposits may be required.

DEFINITIONS:

Actual Cost - Actual cost is defined as the full cost incurred by the City in performing a service including, but not limited to, the fully burdened overhead rate for staff time, full burdened overtime rate for staff services performed after normal working hours, the cost for materials, vehicles, equipment, and contracts. Material costs include any supplies used (i.e., paper, water meter, pipe, etc.). Vehicle costs are based on hourly vehicle rates that include operations and maintenance costs, replacement cost of vehicle, overhead/administrative costs, insurance, accident repair costs, and fuel. Contract costs is the cost for a contractor to perform work on behalf of the City. Fully burdened overhead and overtime rates are updated at least once per fiscal year when significant changes to salaries, benefits and/or overhead rates (cost allocation plan) are updated. Vehicle and equipment rates are updated bi-annually as part of the budget cycle. For current rates you may submit a public records act (PRA) request to the City Clerk's office.

Direct Cost - Direct cost is defined as the direct cost incurred by the City in performing a service, including the direct wages and benefits calculated as the productive hourly rate for employee(s) providing the service, actual equipment cost directly attributable to the service provided, and any actual discrete costs incurred by the City in performing the service (ie: payment to vendor for services provided).

Fully Burdened Overhead Rate - a billable rate that captures all costs associated with employees, over and above gross compensation or payroll costs. Typical costs associated with the burdened rate include payroll taxes, worker's compensation, health insurance, paid time off, training and travel expenses, pension contributions, other benefits, and indirect costs including departmental and citywide administrative overhead allocations.

Fully Burdened Overtime Rate - a billable rate that includes only those benefits applied to overtime (unemployment, workers compensation) and direct departmental and citywide overhead/administrative costs.

Failure to pay a fee owed to the City per this resolution shall be deemed a violation of a permit pursuant to NMC sections 3.04.050, 1.16.040 and 1.16.010.

NOTE: All fees incorporated in this fee schedule are non-refundable, unless otherwise noted or identified as deposit based.

Building Permit Fees include Plan Review and Inspection. Plan Review amounts equal 40% of total Building Permit Fee and will be collected at time of plan check submittal.

[1] - Fee for building inspections conducted by fire prevention staff are typically "Fire Final" or "Fire Clearance" inspections. These inspections include but are not limited to inspection of fire extinguishers, exiting components, signage, emergency plans, utility identification, addressing, key box, gathering emergency contact information, travel time to occupancy, file review, inspection documentation and data entry.

[2] - Fire Sprinkler inspections include an initial inspection of rough piping, hangers, fasteners, head location and hydrostatic testing, a return inspection for final approval which includes finished trim, required testing, signage, and any other test required by the applicable NFPA design standard. Additional inspections may require reimbursement of actual costs as required.

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[3] - Alternate fire extinguishing system plan reviews include confirmation that system design meets the manufacturer requirements for design and installation including review of specification, calculating system design, review of proposed location, mechanical and fire alarm requirements. Inspection time reflect the typical time required for one inspection to perform a complete system test of approved installed components identified in the applicable NFPA design standard. Additional inspections may require reimbursement of actual costs as required.

[4] - Standpipe systems are usually reviewed and installed in combination with NFPA 13 systems. Inspections specific to standpipe systems include visual inspection, testing as required by the applicable NFPA design standard, and review of certification documentation. Additional inspections require reimbursement of actual cost as required. Use of fire department equipment or personnel to test flow standpipes may require reimbursement of actual costs.

[5] - Fire alarm inspections include one inspection to confirm design per approved plan, device locations, test system function, communication and any other test required by the applicable NFPA design standard. An additional inspection is included for return inspections to complete additional tests required by the applicable NFPA design standard (i.e. 24 hr battery test). Additional inspections may require reimbursement of actual costs as required.

[6] - The following inspections are required for underground piping serving fire sprinkler systems and/or private hydrants: 1) Pre-pour inspection; 2) Hydrostatic testing; 3) Flush inspection.

[7] - These inspections require the completion of an 850 form for Community Care Licensing.

[8] - Fire pump testing and commissioning with pump manufacturer.
