RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NAPA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,  
ESTABLISHING MOTION PICTURE PRODUCTION FEES

WHEREAS, Motion Picture Production Fees needed to be revised and updated due to changes in the Motion Picture Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the cost of providing such Motion Picture Production Fee Applications has increased substantially; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City Council to recover the cost of services rendered to the public based upon the increased cost of staff processing said permit applications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Napa, State of California, that effective immediately upon adoption of this resolution these fees will go into place as follows:

Police, Fire, or other non-safety public vehicles will be charged according to rates outlined in Policy Resolution 16 and the Fleet Rental Rate Schedule for the current FY.

Police & Fire Facilities, Vehicles and Personnel Availability Shall Be Determined on a Case-by-Case Basis and Shall Be Subject to Conditions.

The Motion Picture Production Application Fee will be set at \$250 per permit and adjusted as necessary.

PURPOSE: Revenues received from these fees will be used to offset staff time associated with the processing the motion picture production applications and to also reimburse the city for use of city facilities and personnel associated with the processing said permits.
